I like the suggestion by reviewer 4 to also evaluate the occurence of bipolar volanic events in the 50 years *after* a DO onset. If that number also exceeds the expectation form the null hypothesis, this would provide clear evidence that the bipolar volcanic catalogue is biased toward periods of abrupt climate chagne.
