We have checked your manuscript, and unfortunately, at the moment, it does not comply with our 'Code and Data Policy'. Currently, you archive the code of your model in Github. However, as we state in our policy and Github on its website, it is not a suitable repository for long-term archival.

Therefore, please, move your code to one of the suitable repositories that we list before the end of the Discussions period and make the necessary changes in the manuscript in potential reviewed versions.

Also, I have seen that your code is not licensed. Released software should have a license, otherwise it can not be checked or used by third parties (including reviewers, editors, etc.). I would recommend you to use a free software license to better comply with the aim of our journal and scientific reproducibility. For example, if you chose Zenodo as the repository for your code, I would encourage you to choose the GPLv3 license.
