We have revised the MS based on your suggestions.

I recommend redoing the analysis with just ET versus P as a cleaner test of the differences between genera. As suggested we have redone the analysis. As noted in my earlier comment the difference between genera is still non-significant. This is now included as an extra figure. It also provided additional basis for further discussion of the effect of soil depth

While differences in wood production between genera are briefly mentioned, some more discussion on this topic would be useful. We have added a couple of sentenced to he discussion regarding wood / water

It would also be useful to test if there are any differences between the different method. We have analysed the data to compare between methods. No effect of measurement method was detected

We have also added more detail to the supplementary materias as suggested
