Line 35: We believe this form of reference to a whole journal issue is correct.

Line 53: Dipl. Phys. is explained in parentheses.

In line 251, "guy" is indeed correct. Among other meanings it includes: "A rope, cord, or cable used to steady, guide, or secure something. tr.v. guyed, guy·ing, **guys** To steady, guide, or secure with a rope, cord, or cable. [Partly from Middle English gie, guide, **guy** (from Old French guie, from guier, to guide; see weid- in Indo-European roots) (www.thefreedictionary.com)
