Dear Editor,

In our response to the reviewers we have commented on every remark and indicate what we propose to change in a revised manuscript. There are many small points, but also some major issues we want to summarize here for your convenience:

- All calculations will be repeated with a water-depth dependent calving law. This deals with a great part of the comments on calving and bed topography.
- The limitations of the Minimal Glacier Model will be spelled out more clearly, including a statement that the tributary glaciers are just buckets that supply mass when they have a positive budget.
- Our modelling strategy, especially with regard to the meteorological forcing, will be described in more detail.
